RESOLUTION 05-01-11-92

A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF THE SUBMISSION OF A PROPOSAL TO THE CENTRAL MINNESOTA INITIATIVE FUND FOR SOCIAL SERVICE SUPPORT

WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Reservation Band Assembly (Reservation Business Committee) is the duly elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians; and,

WHEREAS, the number one priority of the Mille Lacs Band Assembly is to improve the overall quality of life for the people of the Mille Lacs Reservation; and,


WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Reservation Band Assembly respectfully request funding assistance from the Central Minnesota Initiative Fund to strengthen our Social Service Division.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians does hereby approve and authorize the submission of a proposal for assistance to Central Minnesota Initiative Fund for Social Service Support.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Commissioner of Administration and the Commissioner of Human Services are authorized to sign on behalf of the Non-Removable Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians.

BE IT FURTHER AND FINALLY RESOLVED, that in the absence of the Commissioner of Administration, it is hereby authorized that the Assistant Commissioner of Administration be authorized to sign on behalf of the Commissioner of Administration.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, we, the Administrative Policy Board hereunto cause to have set the signature of the Chief Executive to be affixed to this resolution and forwarded to the Band Assembly for concurrence.
