RESOLUTION 04-04-25-92

A RESOLUTION RATIFYING LOAN DOCUMENTS FOR A FIVE MILLION DOLLAR CONSTRUCTION LOAN BETWEEN THE CORPORATE COMMISSION AND PEOPLES BANK OF COMMERCE TO PARTIALLY FINANCE CONSTRUCTION OF THE GRAND CASINO MILLE LACS, A GAMING OPERATION TO BE CONDUCTED IN DISTRICT I OF THE MILLE LACS RESERVATION.

- WHEREAS, the Corporate Commission of the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians (the "Commission") is empowered to enter into contractual agreements for purposes of, among other things, improving the economy of the Reservation; and,
- WHEREAS, Pursuant to Band Statute 1141-MLC-2 Section 5.05, the Band Assembly is required to ratify and the Chief Executive is required to concur with the ratification of any such agreements signed by the Commission; and,
- WHEREAS, the Corporate Commission has entered into a \$5,000,000 Real Estate Construction and Term Note; Construction and Term Loan Agreement; Leasehold Mortgage, Security Agreement, Fixture Financing Statement and Assignment of Leases and Rents; a Security Agreement; Assignment of Income Agreement; and a Certificate of No Hazardous Waste (collectively referred to as the "Loan Documents") all with the Peoples Bank of Commerce; and,
- WHEREAS, the Commission has entered into the Loan Documents to partially fund the construction of the Grand Casino Mille Lacs; and
- WHEREAS, the Commission has determined that entering into these Loan Documents is in the best interest of the Band; and,
- WHEREAS, the Band Assembly has reviewed the substance of the Loan documents, and has come to the conclusion that the ratification of the Loan Documents is in the best interest of the Band.
- NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Band Assembly of the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians, pursuant to band Statute 2001-MLC ss 5.05, ratifies the Loan Documents entered into between the Corporate Commission and the Peoples Bank of Commerce to provide \$5,000,000 toward the construction of the Grand Casino Mille Lacs, together with any and all other documents, agreements, and instruments related thereto, which have been executed by the Corporate Commissioner and/or the Band and delivered to Peoples Bank of Commerce.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Doug Twait, as the Corporate Commissioner, is hereby authorized and directed to execute and deliver such other documents and take such other actions as may be necessary and appropriate to carry out the foregoing resolution, the acceptability and approval of said documents by the Commission (and the undersigned) to be conclusively evidenced by the execution of said documents by Doug Twait, as Corporate Commissioner.
