RESOLUTION 05-01-01-92

A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE MILLE LACS BAND OF CHIPPEWA INDIANS TO SUBMIT A PROPOSAL TO ADMINISTRATION FOR NATIVE AMERICANS

WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Reservation Band Assembly (Reservation Business Committee) is the duly elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians; and,

WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band is desirous to improve and protect the safety and well being of the Band Members as well as the general public on lands under the jurisdiction of the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians; and,


WHEREAS, the Non-Removable Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians is authorized to request funding from the Administration for Native Americans to expand and improve law enforcement efforts in effect on the Mille Lacs Reservation; and,

WHEREAS, self-sufficiency and self-governance is a paramount and overriding value of the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians; and,

WHEREAS, self-governance is a positive step towards preserving and reviving the elements of our tribal culture.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians does hereby approve and authorize the submission of a proposal to Administration for Native Americans.
