A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF OJIBWE MEKANA, (A NON-PROFIT ORGANIZATION REGISTERED IN THE STATE OF MINNESOTA) AN OJIBWE LANGUAGE CURRICULUM LABORATORY

- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Reservation Band Assembly is the duly elected governing body of the Non-Removable Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe Indians; and,
- WHEREAS, the number one priority of the Band Assembly is to improve the overall quality of life for its band members: and,
- WHEREAS, the Band Assembly believes that the Oiibwe Language and Ojibwe culture is integral to the quality of life for the Mille Lacs Band; and,
- WHEREAS, Ojibwe Mekana, an Ojibwe Language Curriculum Laboratory located at 1305 London Road, Suite 204, Duluth, MN 55805 is undertaking a major effort to preserve and encourage the use of the ojibwe language via curriculum development.
- NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe does hereby endorses and encourages the work of Ojibwe Mekana in their efforts to preserve the Ojibwe language.
- WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing resolution was duly concurred with and adopted at a regular session of the Band Assembly in Legislative council assembled, a quorum of Legislators being present, held on the 14th day of July, 1992 at District II Community Center East Lake, Minnesota by a vote of 3 FOR, 0 AGAINST, 0 SILENT.
