## Resolution 04-04-05-92

A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF A PROPOSAL TO THE STATE OF MINNESOTA JOBS AND TRAINING AGENCY ON 3% OLDER WORKER PROGRAM FOR THE ELDERLY NATIVE AMERICANS.

- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly is the duly elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians and has the power and authority to make recommendations that will improve the economic status of the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians; and,
- WHEREAS, the number one priority of the Mille Lacs Band Assembly is to improve the overall quality of life for the people of the Mille Lacs Reservation; and,
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians fully support the Jobs and Training in its efforts to improve the services to the elderly members of the Mille Lacs Reservation.
- NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians does hereby approve and authorize the submission of a proposal for grant to assistance to the State of Minnesota Jobs and Training Agency on 3% Older Worker Program for the Elderly Native Americans.
- IN WITNESS WHEREOF, we, the Administrative Policy Board hereunto cause the have set the hand of the Chief Executive to be affixed to this resolution and forwarded to the Band Assembly for concurrence.
