RESOLUTION 05-01-46-92

A RESOLUTION GRANTING A ELECTRICAL SERVICE LINE AGREEMENT TO MILLE LACS ELECTRIC COOPERATIVE FOR ELECTRICAL SERVICES TO CELLULAR PHONE COMPANY.

- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Reservation Band Assembly (Reservation Business Committee) is the duly elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians; and,
- WHEREAS, Mille Lacs Electric Cooperative is desirous of obtaining a right of way for the use on the premises in connection with said land leases; and,
- WHEREAS, Band Statute 1094-MLC-47, designates rules and regulations governing the issuance of right of way across lands under the jurisdiction of the Band; and,
- WHEREAS, pursuant to this statutory authority, the Commissioner of Natural Resources has reviewed the request of Mille Lacs Electric Cooperative and does hereby recommend that the Chief Executive approve said right of way request.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the request for an electric right of way is hereby granted for services across that part of:
(1) Section 20 T43N-R27W, NE1/4 NE 1/4.
