RESOLUTION 05-01-52-92

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING GRAND CASINO MILLE LACS AND GRAND CASINO HINCKLEY TO CHOOSE TO OPT INTO THE STATE OF MINNESOTA'S UNEMPLOYMENT INSURANCE POOL TO PROVIDE COVERAGE FOR THEIR EMPLOYEES.

- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly (Reservation Business Committee) is the duly elected governing body for the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians; and
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians is the owner of Grand Casino Mille Lacs and Grand Casino Hinckley; and
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians, as a sovereign nation, may choose whether or not to participate in the State of Minnesota's unemployment insurance pool; and
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians desires to provide unemployment insurance coverage for its casino employees.
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that Grand Casino Mille Lacs and Grand Casino Hinckley are authorized to choose to opt into the State of Minnesota's unemployment insurance pool.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians reserves its right, as a sovereign nation, to withdraw at a later date from any unemployment insurance coverage assumed pursuant to this resolution in accordance with any provisions of the assumed coverage governing withdrawal.
- WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing resolution was duly concurred with and adopted at a special session of the Band Assembly in legislative council assembled, a quorum of Legislators being present, held on the 5th day of June, 1992 at Vineland, Minnesota, by a vote of 3 FOR, O AGAINST, O SILENT.
