Resolution 05-01-51-92

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE HOUSING AUTHORITY APPLICATION FOR FUNDING TO CONSTRUCT NEW HOUSING ON THE MILLE LACS RESERVATION.

- WHEREAS, the Mille Band of Chippewa Indians Band Assembly is the duly elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Reservation; and
- WHEREAS, number one priority of the Mille Lacs Band Assembly is to improve the overall quality of life for the people of the Mille Lacs Reservation; and
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Indian Reservation suffers tremendously from a clearly documented shortage of decent affordable housing; and
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians has not received any housing assistance from the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development; and
- WHEREAS, the lack of housing assistance for the past five years from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development has made a desperate housing situation on the Reservation into a full blown housing crisis; and
- NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved, that the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians hereby approves this application from the Mille Lacs Reservation Housing Authority for new housing construction to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development pursuant to the United States Housing Act of 1937; and
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians authorizes the submission of this application from the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians Housing Authority to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development and supports their efforts to alleviate the housing shortage on the Mille Lacs Reservation.
- IN WITNESS WHEREOF, we, the Administrative Policy Board hereunto cause to have set the signature of the Chief Executive to be affixed to this resolution and forwarded to the Band Assembly for concurrence.
