## RESOLUTION 05-01-90-92

A RESOLUTION BY THE MILLE LACS BAND OF OJIBWE INDIANS AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF PROPOSAL(S) FOR FUNDING OF PROGRAMS RELATED TO ELDERLY, HANDICAPPED AND HOME HEALTH SERVICES.

- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Reservation Band Assembly (Reservation Business Committee) is the duly elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians; and,
- WHEREAS, the number one priority of the Band Assembly is to improve the overall quality of life, also services to the Elderly, Handicapped, and children are to be considered top priority in this category; and,
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe Indians is developing proposals for funding programs through public and private foundations to assist the Elderly, Handicapped, Children, and Home Health Services; and,
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Reservation Band Assembly hereby approves and authorizes the submission of proposal(s) for funding to Public and Private foundations for services to the Elderly, Handicapped, Children, and Home Health Services of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe Indians.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Commissioner of Administration and The Commissioner of Health and Human Services are authorized to sign on behalf of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe Indians.
