RESOLUTION 05-01-47-92

A RESOLUTION GRANTING A RIGHT OF WAY ACROSS THE FOLLOWING TRIBAL OWNED LAND FOR A 69KV TRANSMISSION LINE TO UNITED POWER ASSOCIATION.

- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Reservation Band Assembly (Reservation Business Committee) is the duly elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians; and,
- WHEREAS, United Power Association is desirous of obtaining a right of way for the use on the premises in connection with said land leases; and,
- WHEREAS, Band Statute 1094-MLC-47, designates rules and regulations governing the issuance of right of way across lands under the jurisdiction of the Band; and,
- WHEREAS, such right-of-way shall consist of a distance of 50 feet on each side of the centerline of the transmission line; and,
- WHEREAS, transmission line as finally constructed consisting of single pole, guy wire and anchor; and,
- WHEREAS, pursuant to this statutory authority, the Commissioner of Natural Resources has reviewed the request of United Power Association and does hereby recommend that the Chief Executive approve said right of way request.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the request for an electric right of way is hereby granted for services across that part of:

- (1) Section 7 T43N, R27W, SW1/4 SE1/4 & SE1/4 SW1/4
- (2) Section 18 T43N R27W, Govt Lot 6
- (3) Section 29, N1/2 NE1/4

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I, *Don Wells*, Commissioner of Natural Resources do hereunto recommend the signature of the Chief Executive to be affixed to this resolution and forwarded to the Band Assembly for concurrence.
