RESOLUTION 05-01-57-92

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING A SCHOOL TO COMBINE HEADSTART AND DAYCARE PROGRAMS WITH KINDERGARTEN THROUGH GRADE 3 CLASSES IN A SINGLE FACILITY.

- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Reservation Band Assembly (Reservation Business Committee) is the duly elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians; and
- WHEREAS, the Band Assembly is empowered by Band Statutes 1141-MLC-2, Sections 5.01 and 5.04 to adopt resolutions which promote the general welfare; and
- WHEREAS, the number one priority of the Mille Lacs Band Assembly is to improve the overall quality of life for the people of the Mille Lacs Reservation; and
- WHEREAS, the education and care of the children is essential to the general welfare; and
- WHEREAS, Childcare, Headstart and primary grades all offer education as a significant part of their programs and their related goals could best be accomplished in a separate and less intimidating facility.
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians hereby approves of the establishment of a school to combine Headstart and Daycare programs with kindergarten through Grade 3 classes.
- IN WITNESS WHEREOF, we, the Administration Policy Board hereunto cause to have set the signature of the Chief Executive to be affixed to this resolution and forwarded to the Band Assembly for concurrence.
