RESOLUTION 05-02-78-92

A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THAT THE BUREAU OF INDIAN AFFAIRS PUT LAND IN TRUST FOR THE MILLE LACS BAND OF CHIPPEWA INDIANS.

- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Reservation Band Assembly is the duly elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe; and
- WHEREAS, the Minnesota Historical Society is transferring approximately 101 acres to the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians; and,
- WHEREAS, the Minnesota Historical Society wishes to put these lands in trust for the Mille Lacs Reservation; and,
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe will accept the following land to be put in trust:

Government Lot 1, Section 22; Government Lots 1 and 2, Section 27; Government Lot 1, Section 26; and the Southwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of Section 28, except a 5 acre tract used for cemetery purposes. All parcels are located in Township 43 North, Range 27 West of the Fourth Principal Meridian.

WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing resolution was duly concurred with and adopted at a regular session of the Band Assembly in Legislative council assembled, a quorum of Legislators being present held on the <u>23rd</u> day of July, 1992 at Vineland, Minnesota by a vote of <u>3 FOR</u>, <u>0 AGAINST</u>, <u>0 SILENT</u>.
