RESOLUTION 05-02-80-92

A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF THE SUBMISSION OF A PROPOSAL FOR A HEAD START GRANT.

WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly (Reservation Business Committee) is the duly elected governing body for the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians; and

WHEREAS, the number one priority of the Mille Lacs Band Assembly is to improve the overall quality of life for the people of the Mille Lacs Reservation; and

WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Reservation Band Assembly respectfully requests funding assistance from the Head Start Bureau to strengthen the care of our children.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians does hereby approve the submission of a proposal for assistance to the Administration of children, youth and families, Head Start Bureau.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Nay Ah Shing School Board and the Head Start Policy Council are authorized to sign on behalf of the Non-Removable Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians.

BE IT FURTHER AND FINALLY RESOLVED, that in absence of the Commissioner of Administration, it is hereby authorized that the Assistant Commissioner of Administration be authorized to sign on behalf of the Commissioner of Administration.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, we, the Administration Policy Board hereunto cause to have set the signature of the Chief Executive to be affixed to this resolution and forwarded to the Band Assembly for concurrence.


