RESOLUTION 05-01-27-92

A RESOLUTION GRANTING RIGHT OF WAY ACROSS LANDS UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF THE NON-REMOVABLE MILLE LACS BAND OF CHIPPEWA INDIANS TO THE BUREAU OF INDIAN AFFAIRS FOR THE PURPOSE OF IMPROVING ROADWAYS

- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly (Reservation Business Committee) is the duly elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians, and;
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly is desirous of improving the rights and welfare of its members, and;
- WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs, Minneapolis Area Office, for the United States of America, its successors and assigns, have made application for a sixty (60) foot right-of-way and an easement on additional land as required to construct and maintain cut and fill slopes, which may extend beyond the regular right-of-way across tribal lands in Sections 20, township 47 north, range 23 west, which lies 30 feet on either side of the following described centerline:


Beginning at point 981.07 feet south on a bearing SO-31-15E of the W 1/4 corner of section 20, township 47 north, range 23 west; thence easterly on a bearing of N89-44-45E a distance of 1297.14 feet to P.I. Station 12+ 97.14; thence northerly on a bearing of NO-43-15W a distance of 271.55 feet to P.I. Station 15+ 68.69; thence easterly on a bearing of N89-44-45E a distance of 714.90 feet to a point being the end of project 22+ 93.59, also said point being 2018.20 east and 730 feet south of the W 1/4 corner of section 20, township 47 north, range 23 west, 4th principal meridian.

Located in Aitkin County in Central Minnesota as shown in the map for East Lake Community Street, Mille Lacs Indian Reservation, for the purpose of constructing and maintaining an all weather road, and;

- WHEREAS, all merchantable timber shall be salvaged and cut into merchantable lengths and piled along the road easement for disposal by the Branch of Forestry, and;
- WHEREAS, all brush, stumps, and slash will be buried or burned in a safe and workmanlike manner, and;
- WHEREAS, the purpose plate of the area has reviewed and it has been determined that the proposed improvement will provide an all weather roadway, safer control of traffic, more economical maintenance and benefit the members of the Mille Lacs Lake Indian Community.

WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing resolution was duly concurred with and adopted at a regular session of the Band Assembly in Legislative Council assembled, a quorum of Legislators being present held on the 19th day of March, 1992, at McGregor, Minnesota by a vote of 3 FOR, 0 AGAINST, 0 SILENT.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, we, the Band Assembly hereunto cause to have set the hand of the Speaker of Assembly to be affixed to this resolution.
