RESOLUTION 05-04-184-93

A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE ENTERING INTO ATTACHED MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF VETERAN AFFAIRS AND THE MILLE LACS BAND OF OJIBWE INDIANS.

- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe Indians is a federally recognized Indian tribe, and;
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Reservation Band Assembly is the duly elected governing body, and;
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Reservation Band Assembly is desirous of implementing provisions of P.L. 102-547 (Veterans Home Loan Program Amendments of 1992) for Native Americans.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Reservation Band Assembly does hereby approve and authorizes the entering into the attached Memorandum of Understanding between the United States Department of Veteran Affairs and the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe Indians.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Reservation Housing Authority (an entity of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe Indians) be the tribal agency duly authorized to implement P.L. 102-547 on behalf of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe Indians.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chairperson of the Mille Lacs Reservation Housing Authority and the Chief Executive are authorized to sign on behalf of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe Indians.

WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing resolution was duly concurred with and adopted at a regular session of the Band Assembly in Legislative Council assembled, a quorum of legislators being present held on the 20th day of September, 1993 at Vineland, Minnesota by a vote of 2 FOR, 0 AGAINST, 0 SILENT.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, we, the Band Assembly hereunto cause to have set the signature of the Speaker of Assembly to be affixed to this resolution and forwarded to the Chief Executive for concurrence.
