RESOLUTION 05-02-11-93

A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE MINNESOTA CHIPPEWA TRIBE REVERT LAND BACK INTO TRUST FOR THE MILLE LACS BAND OF CHIPPEWA INDIANS.

WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly is the duly elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Reservation, and;

WHEREAS, the Little Flower Mission requested Congressional Legislation to acquire tribal lands, and;

WHEREAS, the lands requested have not been used for religious purposes, and;

WHEREAS, the land is to revert back to the Minnesota Chippewa Tribe when it is no longer used for religious purposes.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe have requested the Minnesota Chippewa Tribe Executive Committee to revert these lands back to the Minnesota Chippewa Tribe.

WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing resolution was duly concurred with and adopted at a regular session of the Band Assembly in Legislative Council assembled, a quorum of legislators being present held on the 26th day of October, 1992 at Vineland, Minnesota by a vote of 2 FOR, 0 AGAINST, 0 SILENT.


