RESOLUTION 05-04-170-93


A RESOLUTION FROM THE MILLE LACS BAND OF OJIBWE INDIANS TO APPROVE THE APPLICATION REQUESTING FUNDING FROM THE MINNESOTA OFFICE OF DRUG POLICY AND VIOLENCE PREVENTION FOR THE UNITED-TOGETHER YOUTH PROGRAM.

- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly (Reservation Business Committee) is the duly elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe Indians, and;
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly is concerned for its enrolled members, and;
- WHEREAS, the number one priority of the Band Assembly is to improve the overall quality of life for all its members, and;
- WHEREAS, the Minnesota Office of Drug Policy and Violence Prevention provides for funding available to assist Indian tribes in financing programs which are designed to reduce the substantial substance abuse among the youth of the Mille Lacs Band, and;
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe Indians is desirous in obtaining such funds.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Reservation Band Assembly supports the submission of a proposal to the Minnesota Office of Drug Policy and Violence Prevention for the United-Together Youth Program.

BE IT FURTHER & FINALLY RESOLVED, that the Commissioner of Administration and the Chief Law Enforcement Officer are authorized to sign on behalf of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, we, the Administrative Policy Board hereunto cause to have set the signature of the Chief Executive to be affixed to this resolution and forwarded to the Band Assembly for concurrence.
