## RESOLUTION 05-03-131-B-93

A RESOLUTION GRANTING RIGHT-OF-WAY ACROSS LANDS UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF THE NON-REMOVABLE MILLE LACS BAND OF CHIPPEWA INDIANS TO INDIAN HEALTH SERVICES FOR THE PURPOSE OF APPROVING PLACEMENT OF A NEW SOLID WASTE TRANSFER STATION TO BE LOCATED AT VINELAND, MINNESOTA.

- WHEREAS, Indian Health Services is desirous of obtaining a right-of-way for the use on the premises in connection with said land leases, and;
- WHEREAS, Band Statute 1094-MLC-47, designates rules and regulations governing the issuance of right-of-way across lands under the jurisdiction of the Band, and;
- WHEREAS, pursuant to the statutory authority, the Commissioner of Natural Resources has reviewed the request of the Indian Health Services and does hereby recommend that the Chief Executive approve said right-of-way request.
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the request for a right-of-way across land herein described as: Mille Lacs Indian Reservation Allotment No. 130, more specifically described as: the South Half of the Northwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of the Southwest Quarter (S 1/2 of the NW 1/4 of SE 1/4 of SW 1/4) of Section Seventeen (17), Township Forty-Three North (43N), Range Twenty Seven West (27W) of the Fourth Prime Meridian, containing five acres, more or less.
