RESOLUTION 05-04-177-93

A RESOLUTION FROM THE MILLE LACS BAND OF CHIPPEWA INDIANS REQUESTING PARTICIPATION IN THE DEMONSTRATION PROJECT.

- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians is the duly elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians, and as such, is authorized to act on such matters as Band resolutions; and,
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band has been one of the original seven Tribes to have successfully planned for, and has attained, "Self-Governance" status; and,
- WHEREAS, Public Law 102-477 authorizes the integration of employment, training and related services provided by Indian tribes; and,
- WHEREAS, the Department of Interior, Bureau of Indian Affairs has called for applications for participation in the Demonstration Project beginning October 1, 1993.
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians does hereby authorize the submission of application to participate in the Demonstration Project.
- IN WITNESS WHEREOF, we, the Administrative Policy Board hereunto cause to have set the signature of the Chief Executive to be affixed to this resolution and forwarded to the Band Assembly for concurrence.
