RESOLUTION 05-03-89-93

A RESOLUTION OF SUPPORT FOR THE MILLE LACS RESERVATION MANAGEMENT IMPROVEMENT PROPOSAL TO INDIAN HEALTH SERVICE.

- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Reservation Band Assembly is the duly recognized governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe Indians; and,
- WHEREAS, it is the sovereign obligation of the Mille Lacs Band Assembly, as the Governing Body of the Mille Lacs Band, in accordance with the Indian Self-Determination Act, 25 USC, Section 450 et seq., to assume responsibility of Self-Government; and,
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly is aware of the urgent need to develop and provide health and human services programs for Indian people residing in the Mille Lacs service area; and,
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly has established the Health and Human Services Division for the purpose of addressing those recognized health and human service needs; and,
- WHEREAS, the Health and Human Services Division has a critical need to upgrade its' present patient and management information system.
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band Assembly submits, endorses and fully supports the Mille Lacs Management Improvement Proposal to the Indian Health Service Tribal Management Program.
- IN WITNESS WHEREOF, we, the Administrative Policy Board hereunto cause to have set the signature of the Chief Executive to be affixed to this resolution and forwarded to the Band Assembly for concurrence.
