RESOLUTION 05-03-152-93

A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE MILLE LACS BAND OF CHIPPEWA INDIANS TO SUBMIT A PROPOSAL TO THE STATE OF MINNESOTA FOR THE MENTAL HEALTH PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Reservation Band Assembly (Reservation Business Committee) is the duly elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians, and;

WHEREAS, funds are available through the State of Minnesota to provide programs and services to address the mental health needs of the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians, and;


WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians is authorized to request funding from the State of Minnesota for the Mental Health Program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians desires to enter into a contract with the State of Minnesota for the Mental Health Program for the benefit of Mille Lacs Band members.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Commissioner of Administration and the Commissioner of Health & Human Services are authorized to sign on behalf of the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians.

BE IT FURTHER & FINALLY RESOLVED, that in the absence of the Commissioner of Administration, it is hereby authorized that the Assistant Commissioner of Administration be authorized to sign on his/her behalf.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, we, the Administrative Policy Board hereunto cause to have set the signature of the Chief Executive to be affixed to this resolution and forwarded to the Band Assembly for concurrence.
