RESOLUTION 05-03-130-A-93

A RESOLUTION APPROVING COMMENCEMENT OF TELEPHONE SERVICE IN THE UPPER SCHOOL AND THE LOWER SCHOOL.

WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Reservation Band Assembly (Reservation Business Committee) is the duly elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians, and;

WHEREAS, the Band Assembly is empowered by Band Statutes 1141-MLC-2, Sections 5.01 and 5.04 to adopt resolutions which promote the general welfare of the people, and;

WHEREAS, the Band Assembly has previously approved a \$15 million bond issuance to finance, among other items construction of an upper school, lower school and clinic, and;

WHEREAS, the bond issue contains maximum prices for each of these projects.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians hereby approves the commencement of telephone service with Diversified Communications on the following projects subject to the costs listed:
