RESOLUTION 05-02-38-93

A RESOLUTION APPROVING COMMENCEMENT OF CONSTRUCTION OF THE UPPER SCHOOL AND LOWER SCHOOL.

- WHEREAS,** the Mille Lacs Reservation Band Assembly (Reservation Business Committee) is the duly elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians; and
- WHEREAS,** the Band Assembly is empowered by Band Statutes 1141-MLC-2, Sections 5.01 and 5.04 to adopt resolutions which promote the general welfare of the people; and
- WHEREAS,** the Band Assembly has previously approved a \$15 million bond issuance to finance, among other items, construction of an upper school and lower school; and
- WHEREAS,** the bond issue contains maximum prices for each of these projects; and
- WHEREAS,** a joint venture between Lumbar Mechanical and Kraus-Anderson Construction has been previously approved by the Band Assembly as general contractor for the construction of the upper school and lower school.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians hereby approves the commencement of construction of the following projects subject to the maximum price listed:

<u>PROJECT</u>	<u>MAXIMUM PRICE</u>
Upper School	\$3,290,000.00
Lower School	\$2,543,650.00

WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY that the foregoing resolution was duly concurred with and adopted at a regular session of the Band Assembly in legislative council assembled, a quorum of Legislators being present, held on the 31st day of December, 1992, at Vineland, Minnesota, by a vote of 3 FOR, 0 AGAINST, 0 SILENT.
