RESOLUTION 05-03-114-93

A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE MILLE LACS BAND OF CHIPPEWA INDIANS TO SUBMIT A PROPOSAL TO THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE, OFFICE FOR VICTIMS OF CRIME.

- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Reservation Band Assembly (Reservation Business Committee) is the duly elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians, and;
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band is desirous to improve and protect the safety and well-being of the Band members as well as the general public on lands under the jurisdiction of the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians, and;
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians is authorized to request funding from the U.S. Department of Justice, Office for Victims of Crime for the Children's Justice Act Discretionary Grant Program for Native Americans (C.J.A.).
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band Assembly does hereby approve and authorize the submission of a proposal to the U.S. Department of Justice, Office for Victims of Crime.
- IN WITNESS WHEREOF, we, the Administrative Policy Board hereunto cause to have set the signature of the Chief Executive to be affixed to this resolution and forwarded to the Band Assembly for concurrence.
