RESOLUTION 05-04-27-94

A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THAT THE BUREAU OF INDIAN AFFAIRS PUT LAND IN TRUST FOR THE MILLE LACS BAND OF CHIPPEWA INDIANS.

WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Reservation Band Assembly is the duly elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians, and:

WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians has approximately 80 acres of fee land, and:

WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe wishes to put these lands transferred to the United States in trust for the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians is hereby requesting the Bureau of Indian Affairs to accept the following land to be put in trust:

Bryn Property, SW 1/4 of NW 1/4 and SE 1/4 of NW 1/4, Section 20, Township 47, Range 23, Aitkin County.

WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing resolution was duly concurred with and adopted at a special session of the Band Assembly in Legislative Council assembled, a quorum of legislators being present held on the 24th day of November, 1993 at Vineland, Minnesota by a vote of 2 FOR, 0 AGAINST, 0 SILENT.
