RESOLUTION 06-01-95-94

A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF THE SUBMISSION OF A PROPOSAL FOR THE FEDERAL INDIAN CHILD WELFARE ACT PROGRAM .

- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly (Reservation Business Committee) is the duly elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians, and;
- WHEREAS, the number one priority of the Mille Lacs Band is to improve the overall quality of life for the people of the Mille Lacs Reservation, and;
- WHEREAS, Social Service Division works to prevent the breakup of Indian families by implementing procedures and practices to promote the stability and security of Indian children. This project is essential to achieve the Band's long range goals of sovereignty and self-governance, and;
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly respectfully requests funding assistance from the Federal for Indian Child Welfare Act Program. Benefits from the ICWA program accrue directly to Mille Lacs Band members and their families.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians does hereby approve and authorize the submission of a proposal for the Federal Indian Child Welfare Act Program.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Commissioner of Administration and the Assistant Commissioner of Administration are authorized to sign on behalf of the Non Removable Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, we, the Administrative Policy Board hereunto cause to have set the signature of the Chief Executive to be affixed to this resolution and forwarded to the Band Assembly for concurrence.
