RESOLUTION 06-01-106-94

A RESOLUTION GRANTING A LAND LEASE TO the Mille Lacs Reservation Band Assembly (Reservation Business Committee) is WHEREAS. the duly elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians, and; wishes the lease of a lot on the Mille Lacs Reservation WHEREAS. for the purpose of a homesite, and: WHEREAS. a tribal land lease is needed for the purpose of homesites on tribal lands for the Mille Lacs Reservation, and: the lease will be for a period of 25 years plus 25 years effective June 9, 1994 WHEREAS. for the purpose of a homesite, and; WHEREAS. said land is described as follows: the Northwest 1/4 of Northeast 1/4 in Government Lot 5, Section 28, Kathio Township 43, Range 27 West, Block 1, Lot 9, in Vineland Hills, State of Mn, Mille Lacs Reservation, Mille Lacs County, according to the 1982 survey map. 1/2 acre more or less. NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band Assembly hereby approves a lease to be issued to for a period of 25 years plus 25 years renewal effective June 9, 1994. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that leasee will utilize the provisions of this resolution within twelve (12) months, if provisions are not met, lease will then revert back to the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians. BE IT FURTHER & FINALLY RESOLVED, that this lease shall be null and void should the leasee abandon or vacate the above described property for more than thirty (30) days without the prior approval by the Band Assembly

WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing resolution was duly concurred with and adopted

at a special session of the Band Assembly in Legislative Council assembled, a quorum of legislators being present held on the 9 day of June, 1994 at Hinckley, Minnesota by a vote of <u>3</u> FOR, <u>0</u> AGAINST, <u>0</u> SILENT.
