RESOLUTION 06-01-94-94

A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THAT REAL ESTATE PUT LAND IN TRUST FOR THE MILLE LACS BAND OF CHIPPEWA INDIANS.

WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Reservation Band Assembly is the duly elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians, and;

WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe wishes to put this Real Estate transferred to the United States in trust for the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians is hereby requesting the Bureau of Indian Affairs to accept the following land to be put in trust:

Part of Government Lot Three (3), in Section Seventeen (17), Township Forty Three (43), Range Twenty-seven (27), described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the shore of Mille Lacs Lake, Ten Hundred Twenty Five (1025) feet East of the Northwest corner of Government Lot Three (3), in Section 17, Township 43, Range 27, thence South along the East line of the Donald E. Dinwiddie tract to the South line of Government Lot Three (3), thence East a distance of One Hundred feet (100) along South line of Government Lot Three (3), thence North to the shore of Mille Lacs Lake, thence West along said lakeshore a distance of One Hundred (100) feet to the point of beginning.

WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing resolution was duly concurred with and adopted at a special session of the Band Assembly in Legislative Council assembled, a quorum of legislators being present held on the 24th day of May, 1994 at Vineland, Minnesota by a vote of 2 FOR, 0 AGAINST, 1 SILENT.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, we, the Band Assembly hereunto cause to have set the signature of the Speaker of Assembly to this resolution and forwarded to the Chief Executive for concurrence.
