**RESOLUTION 06-01-89-94**

**VOID**

A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THAT THE BUREAU OF INDIAN AFFAIRS PLACE LAND IN TRUST FOR THE MILLE LACS BAND OF OJIBWE.

WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Reservation Band Assembly is the duly elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe, and;

WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe have acquired land within exterior boundaries of the Mille Lacs Reservation for agriculture and housing, and;

WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe wishes to put these lands transferred to the United States in trust for the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe is hereby requesting the Bureau of Indian Affairs to accept the following land to be put in trust:

(A) All of the following in Township 41 North, Range 28 West:

- (1) All of Sections 1, 12 and 13.
- (2) All of Section 24 lying North of the Minneapolis, St. Paul & Sault Ste. Marie Railroad Company's right-of-way as it was located on March 3, 1909.
- (3) The East half of Sections 2, 11 and 14.
- (4) All of the East half of Section 23 lying North of the Minneapolis, St. Paul & Sault Ste. Marie Railroad Company's right-of-way as it was located on March 3, 1909.

(B) All of the following in Township 42 North, Range 28 West:

- (1) The Northwest quarter of the Southwest quarter (NW 1/4 SW 1/4) of Section 36 except the portion thereof described as follows:

Beginning at the junction of the center line of State Highway 27 and the West line of Section thirty-six (36); thence East along the center line of Highway 27 for 400 feet to the point of beginning of the parcel herein excepted; thence South 730 feet; thence East 620 feet; thence North to the center line of State Highway 27; thence West along the center line of State Highway 27 to the point of beginning.

- (2) The Southwest quarter of the Southwest quarter (SW 1/4 SW 1/4) of Section 36.

WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing resolution was duly concurred with and adopted at a regular session of the Band Assembly in Legislative Council assembled, a quorum of legislators being present held on the 21st day of April, 1994 at East Lake, Minnesota by a vote of 3 FOR, 0 AGAINST, 0 SILENT.
