**RESOLUTION 06-01-55-94**

A RESOLUTION GRANTING LAND LEASE TO [REDACTED]

- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly (Reservation Business Committee) is the duly elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians, and;
- WHEREAS, [REDACTED] wishes the lease of a lot on the Mille Lacs Reservation for the purpose of a homesite, and;
- WHEREAS, a tribal land lease is needed for the purpose of homesites on tribal lands for the Mille Lacs Reservation, and;
- WHEREAS, the lease will be for a period of 25 years plus 25 years effective February 1st, 1994 for the purpose of a homesite, and;
- WHEREAS, said land is described as follows: Beginning at the SE corner of Allotment 60, thence North 200 ft. along Spur Drive, thence West 200 ft., thence South 200 ft. thence East 200 ft. to point of beginning in Section 29, Twp. 43N, Range 27W in Vineland Hills Addition, Mille Lacs County Indian Reservation, State of Mn.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band Assembly hereby approves a lease to be issued to [REDACTED] for a period of 25 years plus 25 years renewal effective February 1st, 1994

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that lessee will utilize the provisions of this resolution within twelve (12) months, if provisions are not met, lease will then revert back to the Band.

BE IT FURTHER & FINALLY RESOLVED, that this lease shall be null and void should the lessee abandon or vacate the above described property for more than thirty (30) days without the prior approval by the Band Assembly.

WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing resolution was duly concurred with and adopted at a regular session of the Band Assembly in Legislative Council assembled, a quorum of legislators being present held on the 1st day of February, 1994 at Hinckley, Minnesota by a vote of 3 FOR, 0 AGAINST, 0 SILENT.
