Resolution 06-02-113-94

A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF EFFORTS TO ESTABLISH A NATIONAL HOLIDAY TO COMMEMORATE THE HERITAGE OF AMERICAN INDIANS.

WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly is duly elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians, a federally recognized Indian tribe; and,

WHEREAS, the number one priority of the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians is to improve the quality of life, perpetuate cultural awareness, and to preserve the rich heritage of our people; and,

WHEREAS, the Council for American Indian Recognition (CAIR) a non-profit chartered organization based in Hot Springs, Arkansas is committed to establishing a National Native American holiday to commemorate the sacrifices and contribution made by all Native American Tribes since time immemorial; and,

WHEREAS, the national campaign to establish a legal holiday would be of a long term positive benefit for all Indian Nations as well as the general population, of the United States of America and the Western Hemisphere.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Mille Lacs Reservation band Assembly does here by support the national Campaign by the Council For American Indian Recognition to establish a legal national holiday commemorating the Native American Tribes of the United States.

WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing resolution was duly concurred with and adopted at a regular session of the Band Assembly in Legislative Council assembled, a quorum of legislators being present held on the 12th day of July, 1994 at Lake Lena, Minnesota by a vote of 3 FOR, 0 AGAINST, 0 SILENT.
