RESOLUTION 06-02-121-94

A RESOLUTION GRANTING TRANSFER OF ENROLLMENT TO THE MILLE LACS BAND, MILLE LACS RESERVATION FROM THE LEECH LAKE RESERVATION OF THE MINNESOTA CHIPPEWA TRIBE.

WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly is the duly elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Reservation, and;

WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly screens all membership considerations, and;

WHEREAS, the following individuals have requested relinquishment from enrollment with the Leech Lake Reservation and is requesting enrollment with the Mille Lacs Band, Mille Lacs Reservation, and;

WHEREAS,




have signed a relinquishment form with the Minnesota Chippewa Tribe and relinquishes and surrenders any and all rights, title and interest that they may have in any undistributed property and assets of the Leech Lake Reservation.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band, Mille Lacs Reservation accepts the above individuals for enrollment and recommends that the Minnesota Chippewa Tribe and Bureau of Indian Affairs make the required transfers.

WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing resolution was duly concurred with and adopted at a regular session of the Band Assembly in Legislative Council assembled, a quorum of legislators being present held on the 12th day of July, 1994 at Lake Lena, Minnesota by a vote of 3 FOR, 0 AGAINST, 0 SILENT.
