RESOLUTION 05-04-35-94

A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF MILLE LACS COURT OF CENTRAL JURISDICTION'S APPLICATION FOR 1994 SPECIAL TRIBAL COURT FUNDS.

- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe Indians is a federally recognized Indian Tribe which is governed by the laws of the Band and the powers of inherent right and sovereignty, and;
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe Indians has a governmental; structure which is one of separation of powers, and;
- WHEREAS, the Judicial Branch of Government is charged to interpret and uphold the laws of the Band and dispense justice to those within its jurisdiction, and;
- WHEREAS, 1994 Special Tribal Court Funds are available for application through the U.S. Federal Government which could assist the Mille Lacs Band Court System in training and further development of its court system, and;
- WHEREAS, through the Chief Justice, the Mille Lacs Court of Central Jurisdiction seeks to apply for the available funds for the purpose of tribal court support and training.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band Assembly and the Chief Executive of the Mille Lacs Band does hereby support and approve of the Court's application for the 1994 Special Tribal Court Funds which are available through the U.S. Department of the Interior.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, we, the Administrative Policy Board hereunto cause to have set the signature of the Chief Executive to be affixed to this resolution and forwarded to the Band Assembly for concurrence.
