RESOLUTION 06-02-130-94

A RESOLUTION GRANTING A LAND LEASE TO [REDACTED]

WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Reservation Band Assembly (Reservation Business Committee) is the duly elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians, and;

WHEREAS, [REDACTED] wishes the lease of a lot on the Mille Lacs Reservation for the purpose of a homesite, and;

WHEREAS, tribal land leases are needed from the Band Assembly for the purpose of repayment of home loans-Minnesota Chippewa Tribe Home Loan Program in case of a default, and;

WHEREAS, said land is described as follows: Beginning at the ditch marker steel stake in the SW corner of the E 1/2 of the NE 1/4, thence North 75 feet to point of beginning, thence continue North 200 feet, thence East 200 feet, thence South 200 feet, thence West 200 feet to point of beginning and there terminating. All in Sec. 33, Twp. 42N-R27W, Mille Lacs County.


WHEREAS, the lease will have to be for a period of 25 years plus 25 years effective August 9th, 1994, for the purpose of financing this home.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band Assembly hereby approves a lease to be issued to [REDACTED] for a period of 25 years plus 25 years renewal effective August 9th, 1994.

BE IT FURTHER & FINALLY RESOLVED, that lessee will utilize the provisions of this resolution within twelve (12) months, if provisions are not met, or if the lessee defaults on their home mortgage, this lease will then be assigned to the Minnesota Chippewa Tribe Home Loan Program.

WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing resolution was duly concurred with and adopted at a regular session of the Band Assembly in Legislative Council assembled, a quorum of legislators being present held on the 9th day of August, 1994 at Vineland, Minnesota by a vote of 3 FOR, 0 AGAINST, 0 SILENT.
