RESOLUTION 05-04-28-94

A RESOLUTION AMENDING LAND LEASE AGREEMENT DESCRIPTION FOR

- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Reservation Band Assembly (Reservation Business Committee) is the duly elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians, and;
- WHEREAS, has a lease of a lot on the Mille Lacs Reservation for the purpose of a homesite which was approved by Resolution 83-81-A, and;
- WHEREAS, said Resolution had the incorrect legal description, and;
- WHEREAS. the corrected description is as follows: Part of the Northwest Quarter of the NW Quarter and part of Indian Allotment 11 all in Section 28, Township 43, Range 27, Mille Lacs County, Minnesota, in accordance with the supplemental plat of Sections 27, 28 and 29, Township 43, Range 27, West of the Fourth Principal Meridian, Minnesota, as certified by Frank M. Johnson, Supervisor of Surveys of the General Land office on December 11, 1924, and filed of record in the office of the Secretary of State of Minnesota, described as commencing at the Northwest corner of said Section 28, thence east along the north line of said Northwest Quarter a distance of 329.44 feet more or less to the northwest corner of said Indian Allotment 11; thence southerly along the west line of Indian Allotment 11 a distance of 620.44 feet more or less, to its intersection with the north line of a road known as West Side Road, the point of beginning of the tract to be described; thence northerly along said west line of Indian Allotment 11 a distance of 200.00 feet; thence easterly, parallel with said north line of said road a distance of 100.00 feet; thence southerly, parallel with said west line of Indian Allotment 11 a distance of 200.00 feet to the north line of road; thence Westerly along said north line of said road to the point of beginning.
- WHEREAS, tribal land leases are needed from the Band Assembly for the purpose of repayment of home loans-Minnesota Chippewa Tribe Home Loan Program in case of a default.
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band Assembly hereby approves this corrected Resolution and land description to
- BE IT FURTHER & FINALLY RESOLVED, that leasee will utilize the provisions of this resolution within twelve (12) months, if provisions are not met, or if the leasee defaults on their home mortgage, this lease will then revert back to the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians.
- WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing resolution was duly concurred with and adopted at a special session of the Band Assembly in Legislative Council assembled, a quorum of legislators being present held on the 24th day of November, 1993 at Vineland, Minnesota by a vote of 2 FOR, 0 AGAINST, 0 SILENT.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, we, the Band Assembly hereunto cause to have set the signature of the Speaker of Assembly to be affixed to this resolution and forwarded to the Chief Executive for concurrence.
