NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band Assembly hereby authorizes Melanie Benjamin, Commissioner of Administration and Doug Twait, Corporate Commissioner to become members in good standing in order to fulfill their responsibilities as Official Delegates to the National Indian Gaming Association.
