RESOLUTION 05-04-25-94

	A RESOLUTION GRANTING A LAND LEASE TO
WHEREAS,	the Mille Lacs Reservation Band Assembly (Reservation Business Committee) is the duly elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians, and;
WHEREAS,	wishes the lease of a lot on the Mille Lacs Reservation for the purpose of a homesite, and;
WHEREAS,	a tribal land lease is needed for the purpose of homesites on tribal lands for the Mille Lacs Reservation, and;
WHEREAS,	the lease will be for a period of 25 years plus 25 years effective November 24th, 1993 for the purpose of a homesite, and;
WHEREAS,	said land is described as follows: Beginning at the Southwest corner of Allotment- 57, thence West 150 feet, thence North 200 ft. thence East 150 ft. thence South 200 ft., tract of beginning. All in Section 27, Twp. 43N, Range 27W, in Vineland Hills in Section 27, Mille Lacs Reservation, State of Minnesota.
NOW, THERE	FORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band Assembly hereby approves a lease to be issued to for a period of 25 years plus 25 years renewal effective November 24th, 1993.
BE IT FURTH	ER RESOLVED, that leasee will utilize the provisions of this resolution within twelve (12) months, if provisions are not met, lease will then revert back to the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians.
BE IT FURTH	ER & FINALLY RESOLVED, that this lease shall be null and void should the leasee abandon or vacate the above described property for more than thirty (30) days without the prior approval by the Band Assembly.
WE DO HERE	BY CERTIFY, that the foregoing resolution was duly concurred with and adopted at a special session of the Band Assembly in Legislative Council assembled, a quorum of legislators being present held on the 24th day of November, 1993 at Vineland, Minnesota by a vote of _3_ FOR, _O_AGAINST, _O_SILENT.
