RESOLUTION 06-01-78-94

A RESOLUTION GRANTING RIGHT-OF-WAY ACROSS LANDS UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF THE NON-REMOVABLE MILLE LACS BAND OF CHIPPEWA INDIANS TO GTE COMMUNICATIONS FOR THE PURPOSE OF EXTENDING TELEPHONE SERVICE AT THE EAST LAKE RESERVATION SITE FOR PROPOSED COMMUNITY CENTER.

WHEREAS, GTE Communications is desirous of obtaining a right-of-way for use on the premises in connection with said land leases, and;

WHEREAS, Band Statute 1094-MLC-47, designates rules and regulations governing the issuance of right-of-way across lands under the jurisdiction of the Band, and;

WHEREAS, pursuant to his statutory authority, the Commissioner of Natural Resources has reviewed the request of the GTE Communications and does hereby recommend that the Chief Executive approve said right-of-way request.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the request for a right-of-way across lands herein described as: A 20 foot easement for telephone service across that part of the SW 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of Section 19, TWP 47, Range 23, Aitkin County, Minnesota whose centerline is described as follows: Commencing 10 feet South of the NW corner of said SW 1/4 of NW 1/4, thence easterly and parallel to the north line of said SW 1/4 of NW 1/4 for a distance of 600 feet.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I, *Don Waddy*, Commissioner of Natural Resources do hereunto recommend the signature of the Chief Executive to be affixed to this resolution and forwarded to the Band Assembly for concurrence.
