



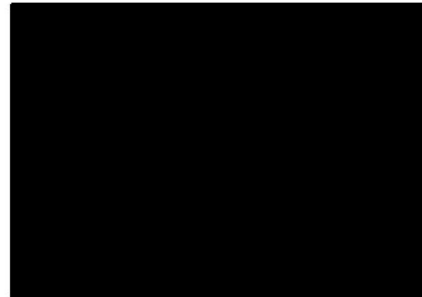

RESOLUTION 06-02-120-94

A RESOLUTION GRANTING TRANSFER OF ENROLLMENT TO THE MILLE LACS BAND, MILLE LACS RESERVATION FROM THE WHITE EARTH RESERVATION OF THE MINNESOTA CHIPPEWA TRIBE.

- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly is the duly elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Reservation, and;
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly screens all membership considerations, and;
- WHEREAS, the following people have requested relinquishment from enrollment with the White Earth Reservation and are requesting enrollment with the Mille Lacs Band, Mille Lacs Reservation, and;
- WHEREAS, the following people are eligible due to their blood quantum and their ancestral background:



NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band, Mille Lacs Reservation accepts the above individuals for enrollment and recommends that the Minnesota Chippewa Tribe and Bureau of Indian Affairs make the required transfers.

WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing resolution was duly concurred with and adopted at a regular session of the Band Assembly in Legislative Council assembled, a quorum of legislators being present held on the 12th day of July, 1994 at Lake Lena, Minnesota by a vote of 3 FOR, 0 AGAINST, 0 SILENT.
