A RESOLUTION BY THE MILLE LACS BAND OF OJIBWE TO PARTICIPATE AS MEMBERS OF THE AMERICAN INDIAN EDUCATION COMMITTEE AND THE MN. INDIAN SCHOLARSHIP COMMITTEE.

WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe is a federally recognized Indian tribe, and;

WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band wishes to become a member tribe in good standing with the American Indian Education Committee and the Mn. Indian Scholarship Committee.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band Assembly hereby authorizes David Matrious and Duane Dunkley to become members in good standing in order to fulfill their responsibilities as Official Delegates to the American Indian Education Committee and the Mn. Indian Scholarship Committee.
