RESOLUTION 06-03-47-95

A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF THE CREATION OF THE GREAT LAKES SELF-GOVERNANCE CAUCUS.

- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Reservation Band Assembly is the duly elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians, and;
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly has initiated the development of a Great Lake Self-Governance to deal with IHS Self-Governance issues in a collaborative manner with other tribes in the Bemidji Area; and.
- WHEREAS, the Great Lakes Self-Governance Caucus is currently a interim name for the collaborative effort and may change in name; and,
- WHEREAS, each Tribe in the Bemidji Area has been requested to submit a resolution supporting the Caucus; and,
- WHEREAS, each Tribe in the Bemidji Area has been requested to appoint a representative to sit on the Caucus.
- NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe hereby supports creation of the Great Lakes Self- Governance Caucus; and,
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe appoints Dan Milbridge to represent the Mille Lacs Band as a member of the Caucus; and,
- BE IT FURTHER AND FINALLY RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe Indians wholeheartedly supports and endorses the creation of the Great Lakes Self-Governance Caucus.
- IN WITNESS WHEREOF, we, the Administration Policy Board hereunto cause to have set the signature of the Chief Executive to be affixed to this resolution and forwarded to the Band Assembly for concurrence.
