RESOLUTION 06-02-26-95

A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF THE SUBMISSION OF A PROPOSAL FOR AN ORAL HISTORY PROJECT ON THE MILLE LACS RESERVATION.

WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Reservation Band Assembly is the duly elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe, and;

WHEREAS, the goal of the Oral History Project is to preserve cultural and historic information about the Band, using interviews with Band Elders. The histories will be preserved through written documentation and audio tape, and;


WHEREAS, the National Park Service has the necessary funds available to implement the project and;

WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe is desirous in obtaining funding for the Oral History Project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe Band Assembly is in support of the submission of a proposal for an Oral History Project on the Mille Lacs Reservation.

WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing resolution was duly concurred with and adopted at a special session of the Band Assembly in Legislative Council assembled, a quorum of legislators being present held on the 2nd day of December, 1994 at Vineland, Minnesota by a vote of 3 FOR, 0 AGAINST, 0 SILENT.
