RESOLUTION 06-03-40-95

A RESOLUTION TO THE ARCHAEOLOGICAL ASSISTANCE DIVISION OF THE NATIONAL PARK SERVICE, UNDER THE NATIVE AMERICAN GRAVES PROTECTION AND REPATRIATION ACT.

- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Reservation Band of Ojibwe Indians is a federally recognized Indian Tribe; and,
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Reservation Band Assembly is the duly elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe Indians; and,
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe is desirous in obtaining funding for the Documentation Project; and,
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Reservation Documentation Project is designed to work with museums and historical societies to document and inspect cultural artifacts, and plan for the repatriation of selected items; and,
- WHEREAS, the National Park Service has the necessary funds available to implement the project.


NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Reservation Band Assembly is in support of the Documentation Project.
