**RESOLUTION 06-03-85-95**

A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE MILLE LACS HOUSING AUTHORITY TO SUBMIT A PROPOSAL TO THE HOME GRANT UNDER HUD FOR 30 UNITS.

WHEREAS, THE Mille Lacs Reservation Band Assembly is the duly elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians, and;

WHEREAS, the number one priority of the Mille Lacs Band is to improve the overall quality of life for the people of the Mille Lacs Reservation; and,

WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly is committing nine hundred fifteen thousand dollars for the purpose of financing the Indian Home grant contingent upon approval of application.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians does support and authorize the Mille Lacs Housing Authority for a Grant Request for a new 30-unit Housing Development Project under the Home Grant.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band Assembly does hereby authorize the Mille Lacs Housing Authority to enter into an agreement with the Department of Housing and Urban Development for a 30-unit Housing Project.


BE IT FURTHER AND FINALLY RESOLVED, if the request for funds is granted that the Mille Lacs Band Assembly does hereby authorize the Chief Executive and Secretary-Treasurer to enter into a letter of credit with a qualified lending institution.

WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing resolution was duly concurred with and adopted at a regular session of the Band Assembly in Legislative Council assembled, a quorum of legislators being present held on the 11 day of April, 1995 at Vineland, Minnesota by a vote of 3 FOR, 0 AGAINST, 0 SILENT.
