
A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF THE MINNESOTA CHIPPEWA TRIBE HOUSING CORPORATION APPLICATION FOR A GRANT THROUGH THE FEDERAL HOME LOAN BANK IN DES MOINES, IOWA

- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Reservation Band Assembly is the duly elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe, and;
- WHEREAS, the availability of safe and comfortable housing is a luxury on most Indian reservation in Northern Minnesota, and providing safe and comfortable homes is a priority,
- WHEREAS, the Minnesota Chippewa Tribe Housing Corporation is charged with providing housing services to the (6) six- member confederation of the Minnesota Chippewa Bands, and
- WHEREAS, one such service is to provide rehabilitation of current housing so that they may become safe and comfortable and available for rental or purchase.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly does hereby, wholeheartedly support the submission of an application to the Federal Home Loan Bank in Des Moines, Iowa, from the Minnesota Chippewa Tribe Housing Corporation.

WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing resolution was duly concurred with and adopted at a regular session of the Band Assembly in Legislative Council assembled, a quorum of legislators being present held on the 28th day of March, 1995 at Vineland, Minnesota by a vote of 3 FOR, 0 AGAINST, 0 SILENT.
