RESOLUTION 06-02-11-95

A RESOLUTION PERTAINING TO NCAI MEMBERSHIP.

- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly (Reservation Business Committee) is the duly elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe, and;
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band wishes to become a Member Tribe in good standing of the National Congress of American Indians; and,
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe meets all requirements for Tribal Membership pursuant to Article II, Section 1(b) of the Constitution of the National Congress of American Indians.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band Assembly hereby authorizes Marge Anderson, who is the principal official of the Tribe, to take the necessary action to place the Tribe in membership in NCAI; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that tribal funds in the amount of **\$1,000.00** based on the Tribal Membership dues schedule of the NCAI By-Laws, Article III, Section 1(b), are authorized to be paid for such Tribal Membership in NCAI; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that, based on membership of 2,790 persons, as verified by the records of the Mille Lacs Tribal Enrollments Office, the Tribe shall have 120 votes in accordance with Article IV, Section 3 of the NCAI Constitution; and,

BE IT FURTHER AND FINALLY RESOLVED, that pursuant to Article V, Section 2, of the NCAI Constitution the Tribe designates the following named persons as Delegate and Alternate Delegates, and instructs them to become individual Members in Good Standing in NCAI in order to fulfill their responsibilities as Official Delegates to the National congress of American Indians 50th Annual Convention and Executive Council Meeting.
