RESOLUTION 06-03-58-95

A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF MARGE ANDERSON AS REPRESENTATIVE TO THE INDIAN HEALTH SERVICE TRIBAL ADVISORY BOARD.

WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Reservation Band Assembly is a duly elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe Indians, a federally recognized Indian tribe; and,

WHEREAS, the Department of Health and Human Services, Indian Health Service Tribal Advisory Board currently has (3) three expired representative positions, one of which includes the Chief Executive of the Mille Lacs Band- Marjorie Anderson,

WHEREAS, Chairwoman Anderson has expressed her desire to again represent the Tribes from Minnesota on the Tribal Advisory Board; and,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Reservation Band Assembly does wholeheartedly support Chief Executive, Ms. Marjorie Anderson of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe Indians as representative on the Tribal Advisory Board of the Indian Health Service for the three year term set to expire in 1998.


WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing resolution was duly concurred with and adopted at a regular session of the Band Assembly in Legislative Council assembled, a quorum of legislators being present held on the 31st day of January, 1995 at Vineland, Minnesota by a vote of 3 FOR, 0 AGAINST, 0 SILENT.
