## **RESOLUTION** 06-02-20-95

A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THAT THE BUREAU OF INDIAN AFFAIRS PLACE LAND IN TRUST FOR THE MILLE LACS BAND OF OJIBWE.

WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Reservation Band Assembly is the duly elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Oijbwe, and:

WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe have acquired land within exterior boundaries of the Mille Lacs Reservation for agriculture and housing, and;

WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe wishes to put these lands transferred to the United States in trust for the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe is hereby requesting the Bureau of Indian Affairs to accept the following land to be put in trust:

Parcel -8 real property in Mille Lacs County, Minnesota, described as follows:

The E 1/2 of Gov. Lot 1, also known as the E 1/2 of NE 1/4 of NE 1/4, Section 2, Twp. 42, Range 25. And the South 8 acres, also described as the South 16 Rods of the SW 1/4 of SE 1/4 of Section 36, Twp. 43 Range 25 and the NW 1/4 of NW 1/4 of Section 1, Twp. 42 Range 25, lying North of the Sault Ste. Marie Railroad right of way, and the NE 1/4 of NW 1/4 also known as Gov. Lot 3, Section 1, Twp. 42, Range 25, Mille Lacs Co., MN.

WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing resolution was duly concurred with and adopted at a special session of the Band Assembly in Legislative Council assembled, a quorum of legislators being present held on the 29th day of November, 1994 at East Lake, Minnesota by a vote of \_\_3\_ FOR, \_0\_ AGAINST, \_0\_ SILENT.
