RESOLUTION 06-03-76-95

A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF THE LITTLE RIVER BAND OF OTTAWA INDIANS, POKAGON BAND OF POTAWATOMI INDIANS AND LITTLE TRAVERSE BAY BAND OF ODAWA INDIANS IN MICHIGAN FOR ADDITIONAL ALLOCATIONS UNDER THE INDIAN HEALTH SERVICE CENTRAL OFFICE.

WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Reservation Band Assembly is the duly elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe, and;

WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe has a full governmental governing board currently consisting of Chief Executive, Secretary/ Treasurer, District I Representative, District II Representative and District III Representative.


WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe supports the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians, Pokagon Band of Potawatomi Indians and Little Traverse Bay Band of Odawa Indians in Michigan that have been recently Federally Recognized, and,

WHEREAS, the three tribes reside in the state of Michigan and the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe feels that federal funding for these new Tribes should be made available through additional allocation of federal funds to the Indian Health Service Central office, and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe is hereby supports the request, that the Indian Health Service provide funding for the new Tribes in the State of Michigan through additional allocations of federal funds to the the Indian Health Service Central Office specifically for that purpose.

WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing resolution was duly concurred with and adopted at a regular session of the Band Assembly in Legislative Council assembled, a quorum of legislators being present held on the 28th day of March, 1995 at Vineland, Minnesota by a vote of 3 FOR, 0 AGAINST, 0 SILENT.
