RESOLUTION 06-03-110-95

A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORTING THE REDESIGN OF THE EAST LAKE COMMUNITY ROAD.

- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Reservation Band Assembly is the duly elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe Indians; and,
- WHEREAS, the number one priority of the Mille Lacs Band is to improve the overall quality of life for the people of the Mille Lacs Reservation; and .
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe support the redesign of the East Lake Community Road; and,
- WHEREAS, this design change we requested because these citizens felt that the current design of an "S" curve was a hazard; and,
- WHEREAS, the BIA and the Public Works Department of the Mille Lacs Band support this request; and,
- WHEREAS, this design change is not scheduled to cost the Mille Lacs Band any additional money to the Band; and,
- WHEREAS, the paperwork remaining to complete is a study of the area to determine if any significant impact of the area exists, and the technical experts from the BIA inform us that in their opinion this change in the design does not have a significant impact on the area.
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe Indians does support and authorize the design change of the East Lake community road.
- WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing resolution was duly concurred with and adopted at a special session of the Band Assembly in Legislative Council assembled, a quorum of legislators being present held on the 7_th_day of June, 1995 at Vineland, Minnesota by a vote of 2_FOR, _0_,AGAINST,0_SILENT.
